 - i. Borges had a call from Sarah Appel (SHP Show Manager) a couple weeks ago stating that SHP would like to return to NorCal
 - 1. Borges met with Executive Committee and Attorney Polly Hey
 - 2. Borges confirmed all NorCal rules will be followed throughout the application process
 - 3. SHP expressed interest in gaining approval for their May 2022 shows
 - Borges communicated that this was not possible due to our rule stating that all show applications must be received prior to 90 days before the event in question
 - b. Borges encouraged SHP to apply for any of their 2022 shows that are beyond the 90 day deadline; confirmed with SHP that approval would be pending proof of USEF license
 - c. Borges notes that we expect to receive 2022 show applications from SHP
 - 4. Board members discuss advantages/disadvantages of having two NorCal shows approved on the same week
 - a. Board members consider that this may create issues with filling medals and certain divisions by spreading the volume of entries across two events taking place at the same time within the region
